The Minnesota Sexuality Education Resource Review Panel **Conditionally Recommends the use of this video for the following reasons and with the following reservations:**

This video presents six HIV positive youths who tell how they became infected and how their HIV infection could have been prevented. Intended for heterosexual youth, this video advises uninfected teens that abstinence and not using drugs is the only 100% effective way of preventing HIV infection. The panel felt that this video must be shown by a strong facilitator who has current information on HIV transmission and other facts presented in the video.

The panel recommends that the video be broken into sections, with each section discussed individually. The panel liked that the video included HIV positive youth telling of their nondisclosure of their HIV status to sexual partners.

The panel expressed concern that GLBT issues are not addressed and that the video is not culturally diverse. No information is presented on tattooing and piercing. Information on nonoxynol-9 is invalid. The facilitator will need to address GLBT issues, tattoo/piercing, IV drug use, and prevention methods.
